

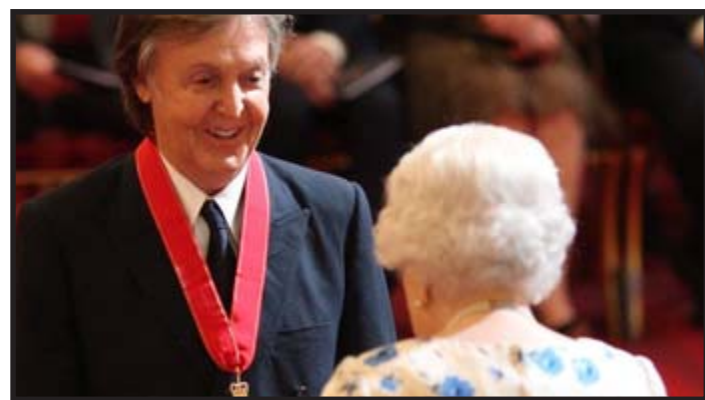
# ACL Music Festival calls Zilker Park “home” for past 17 years
