Project "YOU" workshop embraced targeted compe-

tencies and tools for creating and maintaining a healthy identity, fostering healthy relationships and locating resources to create health action plans for building and maintaining positive relationships with others. Programming outcomes were categorized as short term, mid-term, and long term goals with benchmarks. Goals consisted of the following:

- Short-Term: (1). Equip students with competencies for assessing their mental state
- (2). Refine pro-

gramming for supporting social emotional development, and

- (3). Increase the populace of attendance to include the Girl Scouts organization.
- Mid-Term: (1). Identify coping skills and resources with proven results of combating mental health distress signals, (2) Develop the workshop into a replicable program and (3) Expand the participation of students in workshops.
- Long-Term: (1). Develop as a Mental Health resource to be

referenced and recommended by other organizations, and (2). Garner testimonial data, of former participants, for evaluating the effectiveness of the program on African American female students.

I. Repent: America Racializing, Enslaving America Under the CLaw. God's Love Was Made Illegal: All Lives Couldn't Matter Under Racism, Sexism, Slavery.
Before, During, After Harriet Tubman-An enslaved female, military veteran, led women's suffrage.
America enslaving females and males (People) of America with No Human Rights. America's enslavement included no access/recourse to courts; captive; chattel; persecuted; No wages by law; basic needs/health care withheld at will; criminalized at will; auctioned; bred; gentrification/genocide/segregated by law; conditioned-trained to be enslaved by Supremacy; at will-hanged; hunted; sexed; sold; families split; traded; terrorized.

II. Repent: America OK'd Enforcement of Racism, Sexism, Violence Inequities to America. America's Blind Spots in The Law Made It Legal & Lawful for Racism, Sexism, Slavery to Exist.
Before; During; After "We the People...secure the Blessings of Liberty" (Constitution Preamble).
America enslaving females and males (People) of America with No Civil Rights. Treated as property of: towns; government; systemic supremacy; law enforcement; churches-rejected-restricted by religiosity prejudices; cities; counties; classism; capitalism; states; common law; congresses; courts; presidents; constitution;

America Before-During-After the Civil War-Abraham Lincoln-Emancipation Proclamation.
