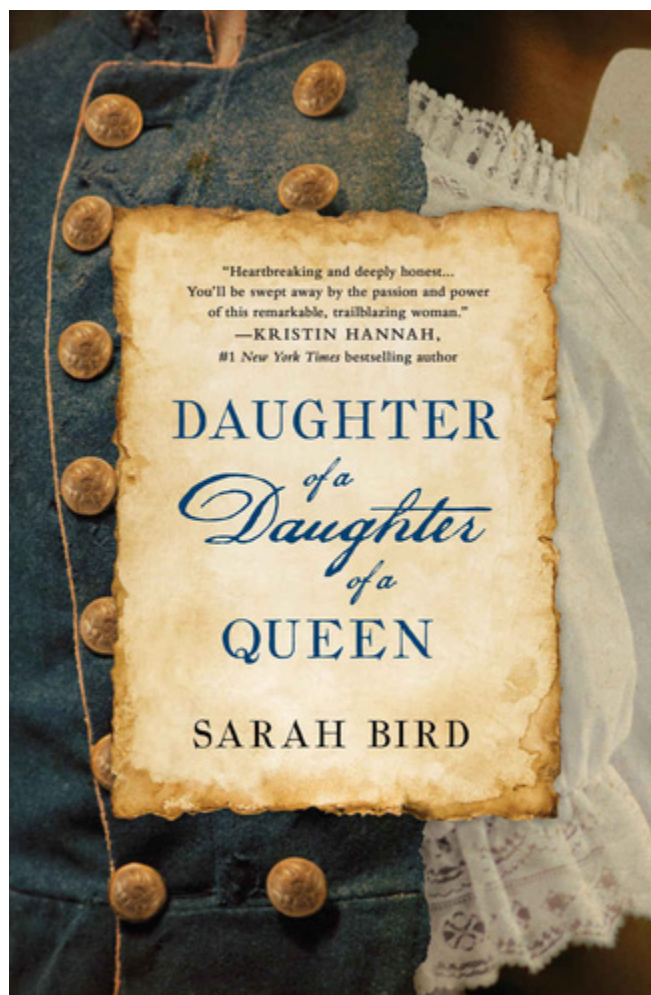
Bird takes a small amount of fact and weaves a compelling story about Cathy Williams. Although Williams is born into slavery, her mother teaches she and her younger sister that they are descendants of a queen. She is the queen's daughter. They are not slaves. They are the daughters of a daughter of a queen the mother teaches them. She also teaches the two of them some of their native African language. The mother has their chest branded and the marks resemble small pearls raised on the skin. Each girl can be forever identified as sisters.

After Williams is separated from her mother and sister from a sale by their owner, Williams vows to never give up in her search to find them.

She escapes and joins the Union Army. She becomes a cook's helper. Throughout her tenure in the army she encounters and confronts many trials in this man's world; but is able to conceal her identity of being a woman. The reader roots for her not to be discovered.
