

# 29th ANNUAL LAKE TRAVIS CLEANUP

**TRAVIS COUNTY, TX** – More than 500 volunteers of all ages will come together to remove and recycle tons of trash and debris from the waters and shoreline of Lake Travis during the 29th Annual Lake Travis Cleanup on Sunday, Sept 17, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. The event takes place on Lake Travis and at parks surrounding Lake Travis from Bob Wentz to Pace Bend.

“The Texas Colorado River supplies drinking water for 1.5 million people (about the population of West Virginia) in Central Texas as well as providing us with fun, recreational opportunities. We are dependent on the River and the river is dependent on all of us working together to help keep it litter free.” Adrienne Longenecker, Executive Director Colorado River Alliance.

The importance of this event is to raise awareness that litter travels, emphasizing the importance of keeping our parks and creeks healthy and clean. If it goes on the ground, it goes into the River. The event is an opportunity to remove unusual trash items from the depths of Lake Travis as well as to pick up trash from parks surrounding the lake and to understand how these vastly different activities are critically important to our shared wellbeing.

The Lake Travis Cleanup is the largest scuba diving, shoreline, and waterway litter pickup in Texas. For 29 years, the community has come together to help protect and preserve Central Texas’ waterways and raise awareness about the importance of our local water resources. The Lake Travis Cleanup began in 1994 as an informal gathering of local dive shops and has grown dramatically each year. The event is now managed by a partnership between the Colorado River Alliance and Travis County Parks.
