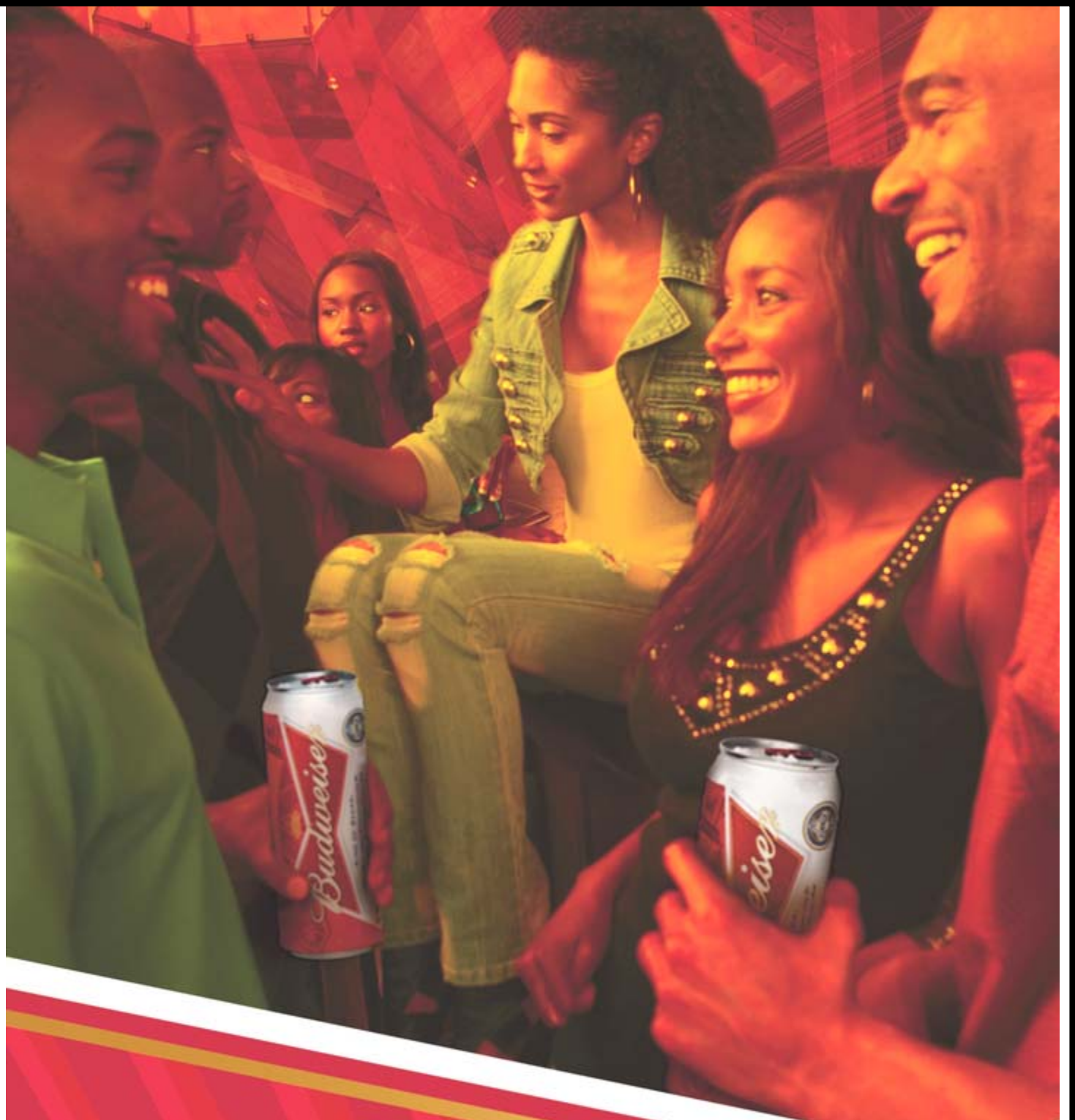

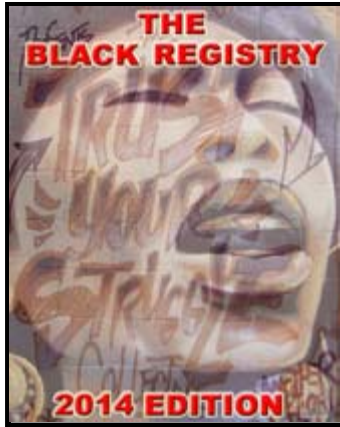

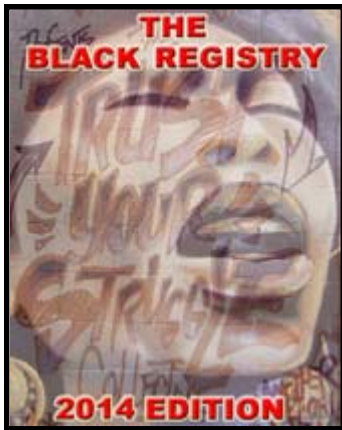

Austin's Historic Victory Grill



Victory Grill is a historic music venue located at 1104 E. 11th St, Austin, Texas. The nightclub was on the Chitlin' Circuit and hosted famous African American acts such as Bobby Bland, Clarence "Gatemouth" Brown, W. C. Clark and B. B. King when Austin was legally segregated. Victory Grill was added to the National Register of Historic Places on October 16, 1998.

...Johnny Holmes, a booking agent and band manager, opened the Victory Grill on Victory over Japan Day, 1945 as a restaurant and bar for black soldiers returning from the war. In the segregated south of the 1940s, these servicemen could not walk into just any place to have a beer. The first incarnation of the Victory was a small "lean-to" building, but Holmes soon moved to a larger building next door.

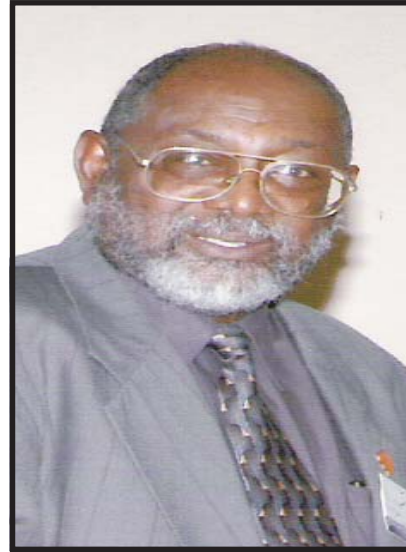
About the Paper

The Villager Newspaper, is a community service weekly that is published and distributed every Friday. The 6,000 copies are distributed in neighborhood businesses, dining establishments, beauty salons and barber shops, pharmacies, clubs, the airport, grocery stores, churches and newsstands in North-east Austin, Montopolis, downtown Austin and East Austin. The Villager is a free paper that's solely supported by advertisement.

Brief History of The Villager Newspaper

The Villager Newspaper is a publication of the Black Registry Publishing Company (BRPC). The BRPC was founded by T. L. Wyatt in 1969 for the purpose of publishing a classified directory of Black-owned businesses in Austin. The first issue was published in 1971, and has been in continuous publication ever since. The directory still remains an information-based resource for individuals interested in contacting African-American businesses in Austin.

In 1973, Wyatt realized the need for a weekly publication that could report the latest in positive news about the African-American community. He noted that most news reported the major media was usually negative. Thus, *The Villager* was born. Since its inception, *The Villager* has experienced continuous growth in the Austin market.

T. L. Wyatt is a fifty-one year resident of Austin, moving here from Lubbock, Texas in 1962. He is a graduate of Bishop College, doing his graduate studies at the University of Washington. He has been actively involved in the Austin community for many years. To name a few activities: He was the first Black to join the Austin Jaycees, breaking the color barrier; worked to recruit others to join the former all-White organization; ran for political office; presently sits on the board of directors of the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP); a member of the City's Private Industry Council; served on the city's first Austin Cable Commission; served as president of Austin Centex Chapter of the National Business League (NBL) for ten years, and is a founding member of the Capital City Chamber of Commerce (CCCC).

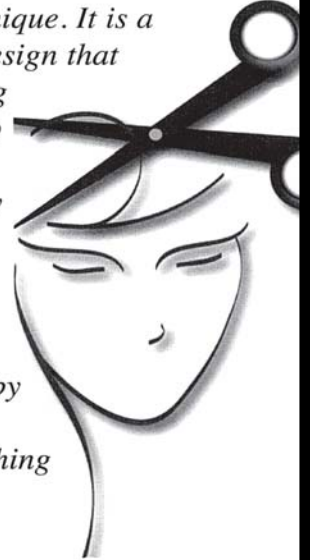

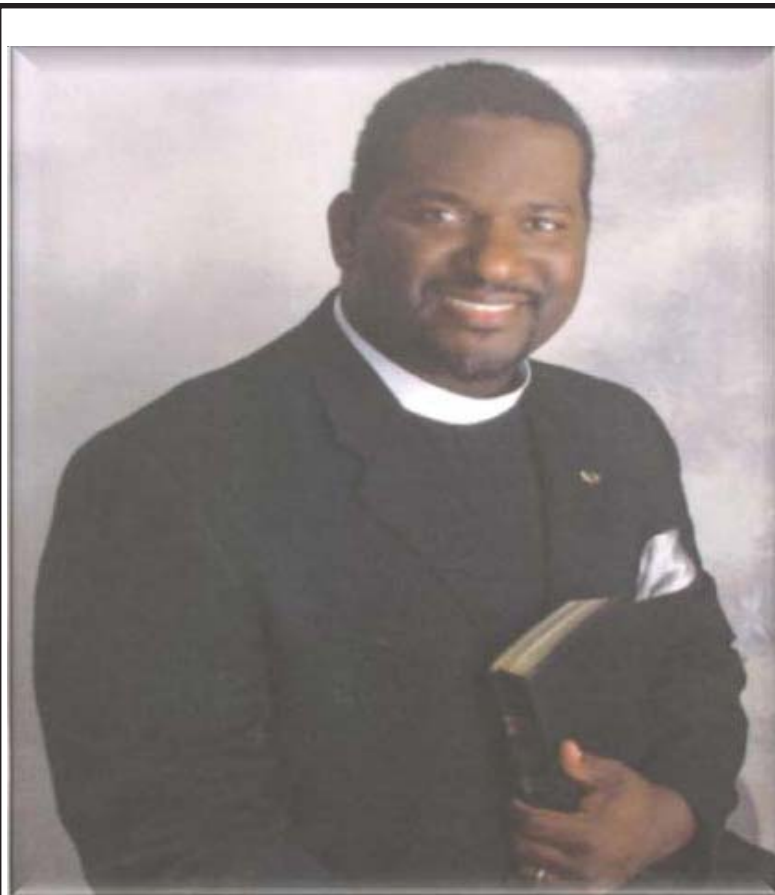

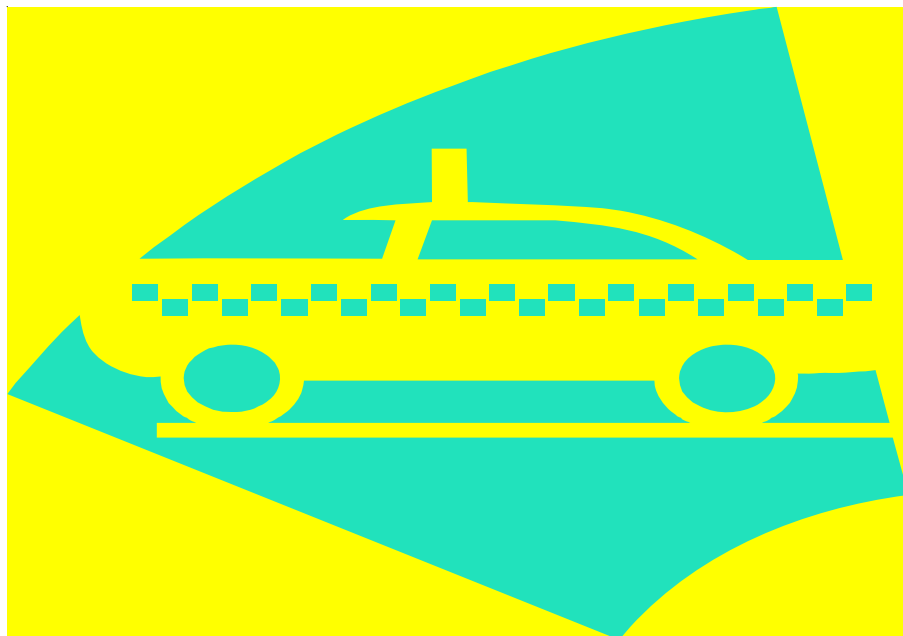

I Did Not Get The Memo!!

I have received many calls from citizens who wanted to know why we are having these business events on Saturday, June 15 instead of Wednesday, June 12th. As a newspaper, we have a responsibility to our readers to report on what is happening in our community. There was a time when African Americans would bring their children to school on Saturday. As a result, in the small town in which we were living in those days, the employees of the store made a decision to let all of their Black employees off on Saturday. They went to work as barbers for them on the school campus.

Later when a resistance group began to form in the Black community, they were recognized as the first Black organization to be recognized as an official state organization. Edwards has since actively sought to spread the observance of Juneteenth all across America.

As the movement spread across the country, many are asking that June 19th become a national holiday. Why then, are we observing the celebration from June 19th to another day for our celebration? The answer is to honor the spirit of Juneteenth as a day of joy.

When the governor of Arizona cancelled the Juneteenth holiday for the year ago, there was a nationwide protest. African American groups and their supporters cancelled all of their observances on the state until the holiday was reinstated.

I am not sure what kind of answer I will receive in Austin over changing the date of the celebration, but clearly there should be a conversation about the community. Let's hope that the Greater East Austin Youth Association is responsible to such a discussion.
